

Drug Testing For Drivers' Education Participants

Out of consideration for the safety of all participants in the Drivers' Education Program, if there is reasonable suspicion that a student driver applicant may be abusing drugs or alcohol, the Program Director reserves the right to require drug testing, either before the student is admitted to the program or during the course of the program. If the student tests positive on the drug or alcohol test, he or she will be barred from participation in the Drivers' Education Program for one year from the date of the positive test. The student may be admitted to Drivers' Education after that time only upon completion of a negative drug or alcohol test, conducted under the auspices of the Program Director but at the cost of the student applicant.
